WHAT?

Following a consortium-wide consultation and a pedagogical evaluation between Blackboard 9.1 with Moodle 2.0, the heads of the Bloomsbury Colleges made the decision to change the Bloomsbury Learning Environment (BLE) platform.

WHY?

As well as providing significant financial savings, Moodle provides increased flexibility, is more user-friendly and offers a great variety of built-in tools and technologies.

WHEN?

All courses and programs will be using Moodle from the academic year 2012-13.

HOW?

The e-learning team will be managing the migration from Blackboard to Moodle, liaising with Course/Module/Programme Leaders and Administrators.
